

- Because the forest owners, who are the cornerstones of the sustainable forest development and whose profiles and practices are evolving, are expecting simple, attractive and modern training tools.
- Because the pupils and students the future professionals in the sector have a major interest in understanding and appropriating the owners expectations, practices and vision.
- Because the trainers and the teachers of the sector, wish to make evolve their pedagogical approaches and their competences thanks to

this type of tools; so that they can accompany their face-to-face activities of formation - that remain indispensable. Because they wish to pool their knowledges and approaches.



- From September 2016 to August 2019, 68 resources will be realized for the forest owners, the trainers of the technical forestry organizations, and the forestry teachers and their students.

- will be developed collaboratively
- will be available on the Internet and in 3 languages for 38 of them (French, Spanish, Catalan);
- will be developed under various training materials (PDF files, slide shows, Prezi, videos);
- will address five main themes in a complementary approach :
- 1 appreciating the production potential of my forest,
- 2 maintaining my forest,
- 3 selling wood,
- 4 producing other goods and services,
- 5 ensuring administrative procedures;
- will be jointly promoted on the respective sites of the partners, under an eforOwn logo and label;
- will be enriched at the end of the program, within the framework of a partnership charter aiming to ensure as far as possible the sustainability of that cooperation and its possible extension to other partners.
