



Figure 7 | SDG Dashboard for OECD countries





Figure 11 | SDG Dashboard for Eastern Europe and Central Asia

Examples

- The European Ecotourism Network (EEN) was the result of 2 European projects (2010 – 2013)
- The EEN members in 9 European countries developed the European Ecotourism Labeling Standard (EETLS) as guidance for ecotourism certification
- The EETLS has been recognized by GSTC (2011)



The European Ecotourism Network EEN is the European partner network of the Global Ecotourism Network GEN. EEN is using this platform on Tourism2030 to work together and to further develop the EEN.

"The Global Ecotourism Network (GEN) brings together the world's regional and national ecotourism associations, networks and destinations, together with indigenous and rural peoples, global operators, professionals and academicians, to grow the industry, provide advocacy, encourage thought leadership and innovation, and add greater authenticity to ecotourism." (GEN Will)
