






Sustainable Tourism Certification Worldwide

Rol hotel = Rol certification?

Hotel Rol:

- Includes savings (energy, water, waste reduction, improved management and trained staff to CSR, good feelings and market advantages ("the better choice")
- depends on the financial capacity at the certification programme to maintain & improve its credibility and services

Certification Rol:

- Phase 1: development (standard, verification, operation)
- Phase 2: consolidation (# certified hotels)
- depends on the satisfaction of hotels and their interest in ongoing re-certification



A.I.D.A.

Attention > Interest > Decision > Action

The concept of sustainable & responsible tourism is meanwhile widely accepted among all stakeholders

- 28% of German travelers want to travel environmentally friendly & socially responsibly (RA 2014)
- 86% of German destinations expect significant importance of sustainable tourism (Contours/ITB, 2015)

The trends are positive, but the pace is slow: Eco-certified hotels worldwide = 1%

The Austrian Ecolabel ("Österreichisches Umweltzeichen für Tourismus") was the first national eco-label for tourism worldwide. It has been awarded to accommodation businesses, restaurants, travel packages. Green meetings and events have been certified since 2010, and since 2014 conference centres and event locations can be certified.



Green Key

The Green Key is a worldwide available eco-label awarded to leisure organisations, as hotels, youth hostels, conference- and holiday centres, campsites, holiday houses and leisure facilities.

Green Key aims to:

- · raise the awareness of leisure establishment staff and clients,
- · increase the use of sustainable methods of operation and technology,
- · run ecologically sound and responsible businesses, and thereby
- · reduce resource, energy usage
