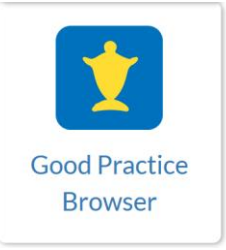
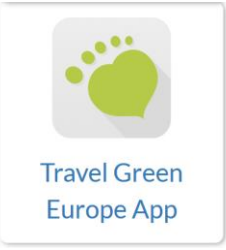
Sustainability auditing in practice!

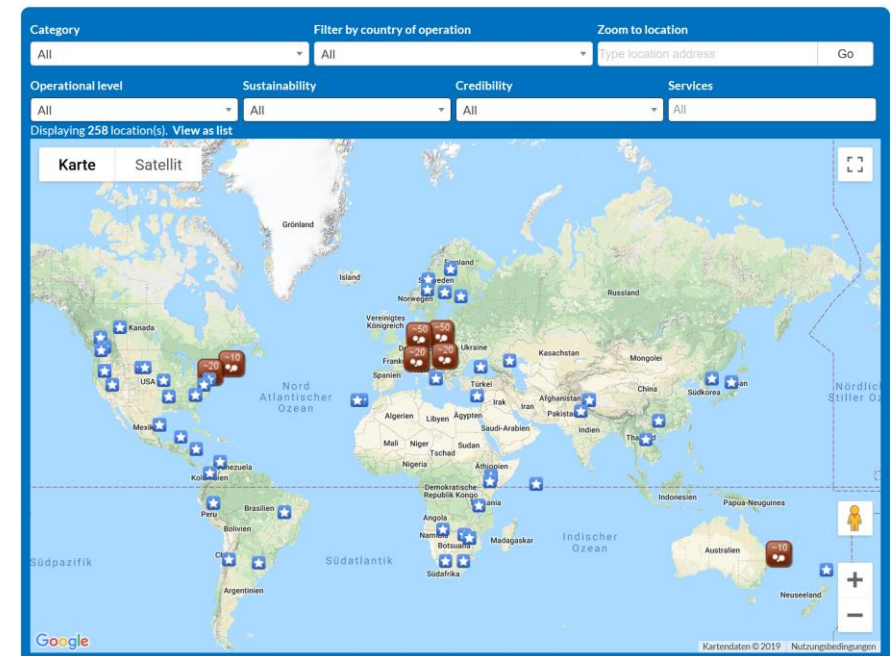

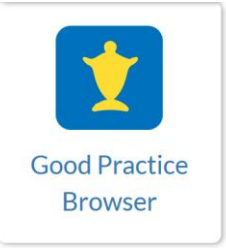
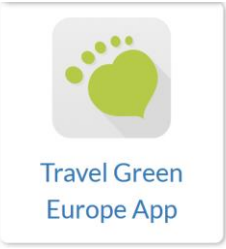
